MARTIAL ARTS CLASSES:

TRADITIONAL TAEKWONDO

Progression of students through the full Taeguk Pattern system (and a few Pulgwe Patterns also) whilst undertaking effective self-defence including throws, takedowns, basic floor work, advanced kicking skills, wrist and arm locks, break-falling and multiple attacker situations as part of the grading syllabus. In addition, advanced self-defence techniques involving weapons such as knives, bats, nunchaku and guns form part of the training syllabus through the higher ranks. Tournament competition is available to students interested in pursuing the Olympic sport element of Taekwondo.



WT TAEKWONDO Competition CLUB

Olympic style taekwondo tournament training incorporating all elements of fitness training, specific tournament sparring drills, match strategy & ringcraft, and contact sparring (age appropriate and according to WTF regulations and best practice). Students undertaking Sparring class should be yellow belt or above. Successful competitors have the opportunity to represent 5th Element at State & National level.



MARTIAL ARTS TRICKING/ACROBATICS

For 5 yrs+ is a training discipline that combines kicks, flips and twists from martial arts and gymnastics. It aims to achieve an aesthetic display of different combinations of "tricks". Examples of tricking techniques include the 540 kick, the corkscrew, the flash kick, the "B" (butterfly) twist and double leg.



WEAPONS

For 7yrs+ No Experience needed. Learn to use: Bo Staff, Nun chucks, Jo Staff, Karba (Scythes), Sai (Mini trident), Jingum (Korean Sword) & Ninja Stars. Class includes hand and eye exercises such as juggling.

STRETCH & STRENGTH

For EVERYONE 7yrs+ but especially FIGHT CLUB STUDENTS (POOMSAE & SPARRING). *** Enhances flexibility, improves mind and body co-ordination, increases strength through correct placement, minimizes injuries, and enhances overall performance.

PRIVATE TUITION



We will aim to keep private lessons on the same day and time, on a term by term basis for those undertaking private tuition on a permanent basis. If your lesson needs to be changed you will be contacted. Casual private tuition leading up to grading will be scheduled around permanent bookings.

Private lesson tutors generally are with Igor Geyl. In cases of emergency a substitute tutor may be utilised at the discretion of 5th Element Martial Arts.

Cost for private lessons is \$50.00 per 1/2hour or \$90.00 per 1 hour.

GRADINGS

Gradings will be offered 4 times a year and are by invitation only (this includes the rare case of double grading). When a student is ready Subonim (Igor) will let the student and the parent know by written invitation.

Grading dates will be set at the beginning of the year but are subject to change.

Grading will be conducted by Subonim Igor Geyl – 6th Dan, and senior black belt gradings will be under the guidance of Master Chris Blight – 9th Dan.

Students will receive an assessment (a written report), a new belt (if applicable), and embroidery (for black belts). If successful, black belts may also like to consider purchasing a new black belt taekwondo uniform to go with their new belt. Black Belts, if successful, will also receive an internationally recognized Kukkiwon Certificate from Korea (a minimum of 6 week turnaround after submission of application applies). Results will be handed out in class.

Term Fees & Payments

- * Classes do not operate on Public Holidays or Brisbane City Council Show Holiday however do operate on Pupil Free Days.
- * Fees are invoiced quarterly.
- * Invoices are emailed prior to the start of each Term and are payable by the end of Week 2 of the Term. If you have not received an invoice at the start of term, please contact us.
- * **Invoices that remain unpaid after Week 2 will incur a late fee of \$20 per student.**
- * Students with fees outstanding after Week 4 may not be permitted to participate in the class.

- * 5th Element Martial Arts will not be responsible for misplaced payments or cash sent through the mail – so please ensure all payments are made by either eftpos, direct debit, cheque or money order unless a prior arrangement has been made.
- * Dishonoured cheques will incur a \$20 administration fee.

Payment Policy

- * **Sick or Injured:** If your child is sick or injured please do not ask for a refund or a credit (see Refund policy).
- * **Cancelling Classes:** A place is automatically held each term for the current year. 2 weeks' notice (prior to the start of the term) in writing is required or a \$20 cancellation fee per class applies (maximum \$50 per student). No refunds applicable for cancelled classes.
- * **Refunds and Credits:** There is NO REFUND OR CREDIT for a student who is withdrawn from the School during a term, or is absent for any reason including illness, school trips or holidays.
- * **Make Up Classes:** Classes on Public Holidays or missed by students can be 'made up' by attending other classes of the same (or similar) level within the current term. There are no refunds or credits for missed classes or public holidays.

SICKNESS POLICY

If unwell (Unless seriously ill or contagious) students should view class for choreography and visual learning to assist their technical progression. If parents DO NOT wish their child to participate in a class (view only) due to illness/injury, a written note must be provided to administration and a "sick note" will be provided for the child to submit to their teacher in class.

BULLYING POLICY 5th Element has a ZERO TOLERANCE BULLYING POLICY.

When bullying is identified, the teacher or staff member will file a written report with administration and a letter will be sent home to parents. If behaviour continues, a meeting will be organised with parents to discuss issues and the child will be temporarily suspended from 5th Element Martial Arts. Any subsequent incident will result in immediate expulsion without further correspondence entered into. Each incident will be kept on file for future reference.

BEHAVIOUR POLICY

5th Element Martial Arts has ZERO TOLERANCE for DISRESPECTFUL BEHAVIOUR TOWARDS OUR STUDENTS & TEACHERS. This includes insolence, rude gestures and failure to follow reasonable direction.

In the first instance the teacher on duty (or staff member) will file a written report and a letter will be sent home to parents. Subonim will meet with the student to re-iterate behaviour expectations & discuss any issues. At 2nd Instance a meeting will be organised with parents to discuss issues and the child will be temporarily suspended from 5th Element Martial Arts. Any subsequent incident will result in immediate expulsion without further correspondence entered into. Each incident will be kept on file for future reference.

REFUND POLICY

Please note that we are happy to provide Refunds in accordance with the Fair Trading Act and the Entertainment Industry Code of Fair Practice.

Refunds will therefore be provided in the following circumstances:

1. When goods are returned as Faulty or Defective.
2. Goods are deemed not suitable for their intended use AND that use was made known to us at the time of purchase.
3. The goods do not match the description or they differ from the sample.
4. In the event of a performance— the event is cancelled or rescheduled.
5. In the event of a performance—the main attraction is cancelled AND a premium price has been paid due to star attraction.
6. In the event of a performance—previously undisclosed significant visual obstruction for a reserved seat reported soon after commencement.

Refunds will not be provided for the following reasons so please do not ask, as refusal may offend:

1. When the customer has changed their mind.
2. Where a customer has found the goods cheaper elsewhere or decides they cannot afford the item.
3. Where a fault was made known to a customer at the time of sale or the customer has caused the item to fail.
4. Where, due to unforeseen circumstances the customer cannot attend an event for which they have purchased tickets.

IN ADDITION:

If for reasons contrary to the above a student decides they no longer wish to continue classes with 5th Element Martial Arts, a refund will not be provided. Term fees secure a students place in class and a 'cap' on the number of students in a class means that once the maximum number of students has been reached in the class, no more students are enrolled in that particular class.

SOCIAL MEDIA POLICY

5th Element Martial Arts recognizes Social Media (Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn, Youtube etc) as an important tool in today's technological world. However, whilst enrolled at 5th Element Martial Arts, students are NOT PERMITTED to do the following without written consent from the Principal:

- Take photos or videos of activities during 5th Element Martial Arts classes or demonstrations.
- Take photos or videos of performances, back stage or dressing room images, choreography or other 5th Element Martial Arts intellectual property.
- Post photos, videos, sensitive content or inflammatory remarks regarding 5th Element Martial Arts, 5th Element Martial Arts related activities, events or performances on social media or the internet.
- Post inflammatory remarks (or what could be considered inflammatory remarks) regarding 5th Element Martial Arts students, 5th Element Martial Arts parents, carers or guardians of enrolled students on social media or the internet.

Students, and the Parents/Carers/Guardians of students found to be acting contrary to the 5th Element Martial Arts Social Media Policy will face disciplinary action, and in some cases, may face expulsion.
